REGISTRATION

The registration process will be carried out through the World Skate Infinity platform and will be open during the following period:

March 09th, 2026 (00:00, CET) - April 23th, 2026 (23:59, CET).

World Skate Infinity is available both on [desktop](#) (browser) and App Version on [Play Store \(Android\)](#) and [App Store \(iOS\)](#).

The Event is an OPEN event but the entries must be done by the National Federations as follows:

Tots, Minis and Espoir:

For the Tots, Mini, and Espoir categories, the registration form must be downloaded, duly completed, and submitted to the following email address:

Content Sheet

Solo Dance – Couple Dance:

Style Dance Music

Music Teacher Certificate
Content Sheet

It is **MANDATORY** to rename all files according to the following format:

Athlete's last name_participation category_program (long-short-style-free)

or

Athlete's last name_content

Cadet, Youth, Junior and Senior: through World Skate official entry platform
Infinity

All single users (Athletes, National Team Members) must individually sign up on the platform either through the app or desktop and create a personal profile (if not already done).

The profile must include all required personal information and the upload of the following mandatory documents:

- Copy of a valid passport
- A recent headshot/profile picture (passport-style with white background)
- Anti-Doping Training Course Certificate

Once the profile has been successfully created, they become eligible to be registered for the event by their respective National Federation.

- **Eligibility:** The event is open to all skaters and couples.
- **Allocation of Places:** When assigning spots to skaters/couples from the same country, priority will be given based on the national ranking provided by each Federation.
- **Quota Limits:** The maximum quota for each National Federation is 4 skaters/teams. After pre - registration, ATC reserves the right to adjust these quotas.
- **Equal Representation:** Whenever possible, an equal number of skaters from each country will be accepted, with a minimum of three skaters per category or discipline.

The same skaters can attend all the World Skate Artistic World Cup.

The Junior and Senior skaters will be scheduled for the short program or style dance in reverse order of their placement in the World Skate Ranking as of the competition date.

Entry fee:

- **95.00 USD** per athlete, per discipline
- **60.00 USD** per Official Coach
- **100.00 USD** Extra official

Registration fees must be paid through Infinity, and can be completed via credit/debit card or bank transfer.

Payment amounts must be free of charge for World Skate.

Please note: if paying by bank transfer, you must upload the proof of payment in Infinity. Without this, the payment cannot be confirmed.

Entry Fee payment deadline: **April 30th 2026**.

Application for Neutral Athletes:

Russian and Belarusian athletes and their support personnel (when applicable) can participate only with a "Neutral status" following the "[Eligibility Criteria for the participation of Russian and Belarusian Athletes](#)".

Application for Neutral Athletes deadline: **April 11th , 2026**.

Wild Card Requests:

Athletes otherwise not eligible to compete may be granted a Wild Card by World Skate.

Please note that a Wild Card is granted at World Skate's discretion and is limited to the cases provided for in the "[World Skate By-Laws](#)".

A Wild Card may be granted in case of lack of an existing and recognized NGB in the country of the athlete's origin.

In the case of a Country with a recognized NGB that does not include Artistic in its activities, the athletes shall mandatorily contact the relevant NGB for approval and clearance to compete for their respective Countries and under their own Anthem and Flag.

Should the mentioned Governing Body not answer within 15 days, World Skate might allow the athlete concerned to compete under his/her Country Anthem and Flag.

Wild Card requests must be sent by e-mail to platform@worldskate.org within **April 18th 2026**.

CUP RULES

For each category/discipline; After the Style Dance and Short program the best 18 skaters/teams will go to the Free Dance or Long Program.

The skaters who do not advance to the second part of the competition will receive ranking points based on their placement in the Style Dance or Short Program.

TRAININGS

The rink will also be available for rent for training at any time when official competitions and/or training are not taking place.

ANTI-DOPING

The doping controls, the sample collection processes and the laboratory analysis will be conducted in accordance with the World Skate Anti-doping Rules, the WADA Code, the International Standards for Testing and Investigation (ISTI), incorporating the requirements of the Technical Document for Sport Specific Analysis (TDSSA), and following the instruction of the World Skate Anti-doping Manager/Delegate. During the sign-up procedure to the Sports Registration System (World Skate Infinity, please see above), all athletes and staff members must upload a valid Anti-Doping Training Course Certificate. Those issued by WADA (through the Adel platform), ITA (International Testing Agency), National Anti-Doping Agencies and/or World Skate during 2024, 2025 and 2026 are accepted. Should you need a new Anti-Doping Training Course Certificate, please visit the WADA ADEL platform and complete the relevant Course, according to your role. We remind you that the WADA ADEL platform is not run by World Skate; therefore, should you have any issue in this regard, you will need to contact WADA's support directly.


VISA REQUIREMENTS
