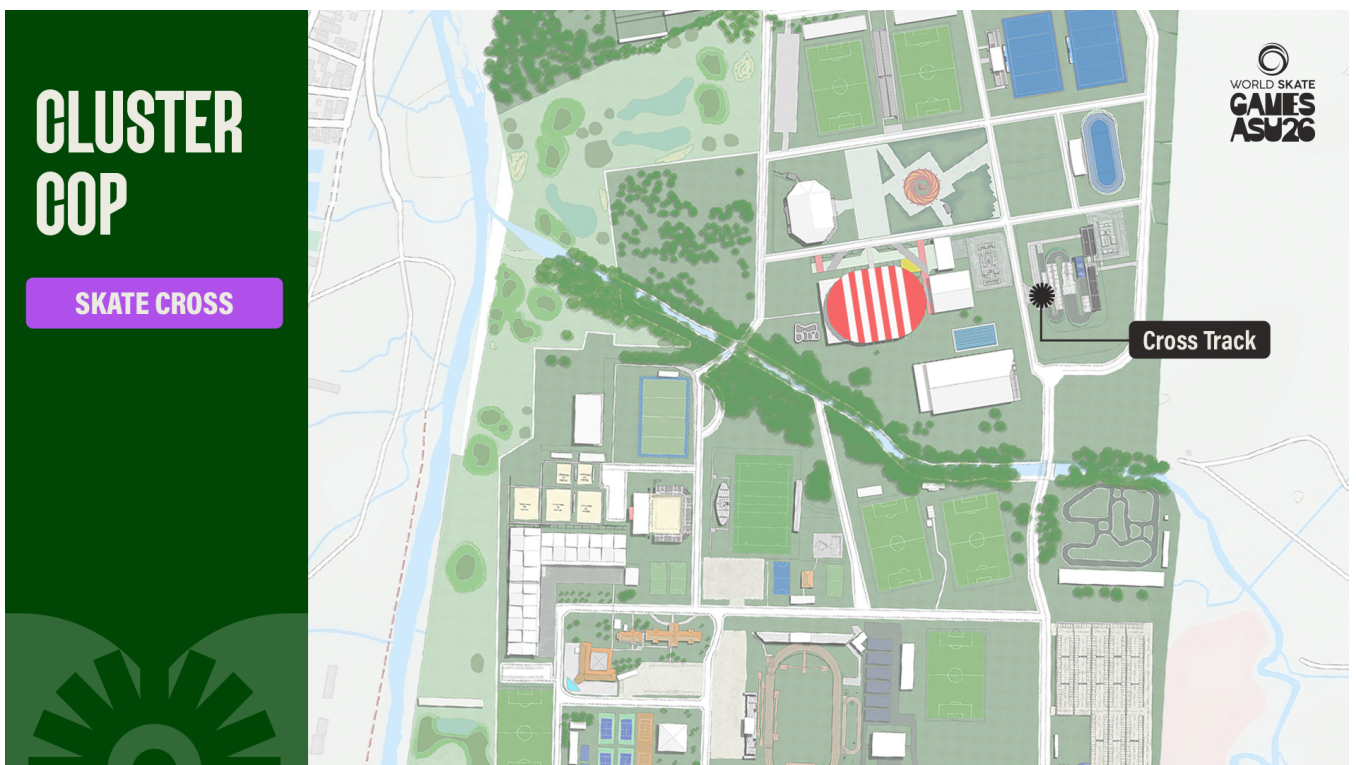
Dear National Federation:

The competition will take place on a dedicated BMX track.

PROVISIONAL SCHEDULE

COUNTRY QUOTA

The maximum skaters registration per National Team for each category, for the Skate Cross discipline is as follows::

Category	MEN	WOMEN
Senior	10	10
Junior	10	10

The maximum teams registration per National Team for each category for the Team Cross discipline is as follows:

Category	MEN	WOMEN
Open	2 Teams	2 Teams

Each skater of each team must participate in the Skate Cross modality. Maximum 20 men skaters and 20 women skaters are allowed for every National Team.

CATEGORY AGE CRITERIA

The Skate Cross categories allowed to compete are as follows:
 Senior (19 years old and up): Born on or before December 31st, 2007;
 Junior (15 to 18 years old): Born on or after January 1st, 2008 and on or before December 31st, 2011.

The age parameter is the age of the athlete in the year of the competition.

REGISTRATION

The registration process will be carried out through the [World Skate Infinity](#) platform and will be open during the following period:

July 1st, 2026 (00:00, CET) - September 10th, 2026 (23:59, CET).

Neutral Individual Athletes:

Russian and Belarusian athletes and their support personnel (when applicable) can participate only with a "Neutral status" following the "[Eligibility Criteria for the participation of Russian and Belarusian Athletes](#)".

ENTRY FEES

Each participating country will pay the following entry fees:

- \$50 USD for each skater who registered for Skate Cross;
- \$50 USD for each team who registered for Team Cross.

TECHNICAL RECOMMENDATIONS & SAFETY

Wheels: Since the competition will be held on a BMX track, we highly recommend using large-diameter wheels (100 to 110mm). The track layout features significant transitions and bumps where larger wheels will provide better stability and maintain speed more efficiently.

Mandatory Safety Gear.

For all official training sessions and competitions, the following equipment is strictly mandatory:

- Helmet (securely fastened).
- Wrist guards.
- Knee pads.

Recommended Gear: Given the technical nature and the speed of the BMX course, a Full-Face Helmet is strongly recommended. Additionally, the use of crash pads and elbow pads is highly advised to ensure maximum protection.
